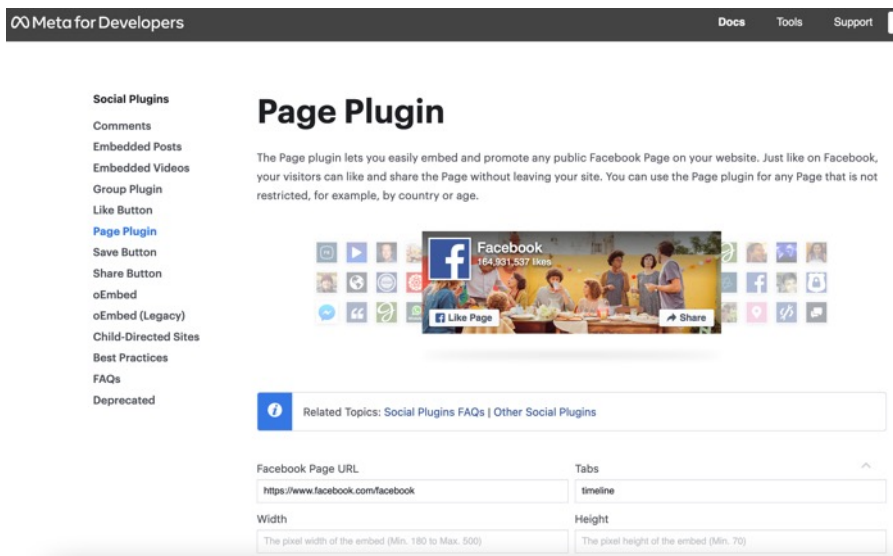
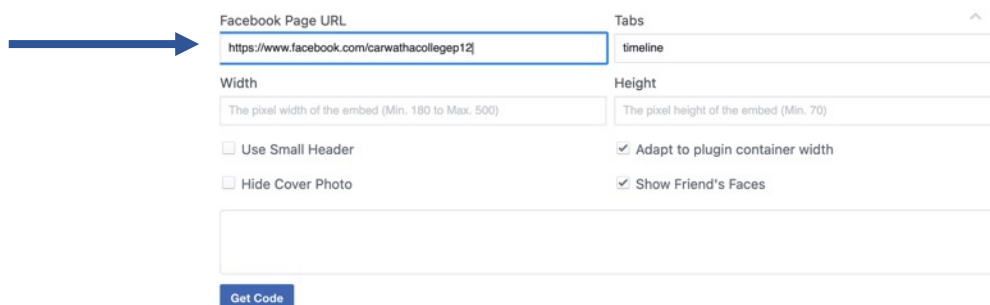


# Adding a facebook feed

Go to <https://developers.facebook.com/docs/plugins/page-plugin/>



- Paste your school's facebook URL in the first box



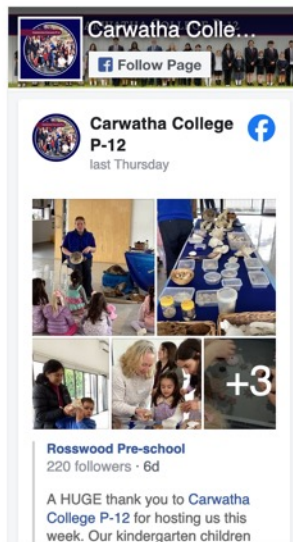
- Set the width to 245 pixels and the height to 400-600 pixels. I will do 450 pixels in this demo.



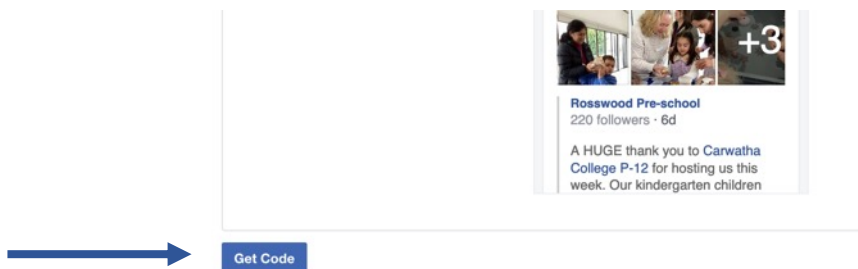
- Underneath these options there will be a check box to **Use a small header**. Check this to YES.

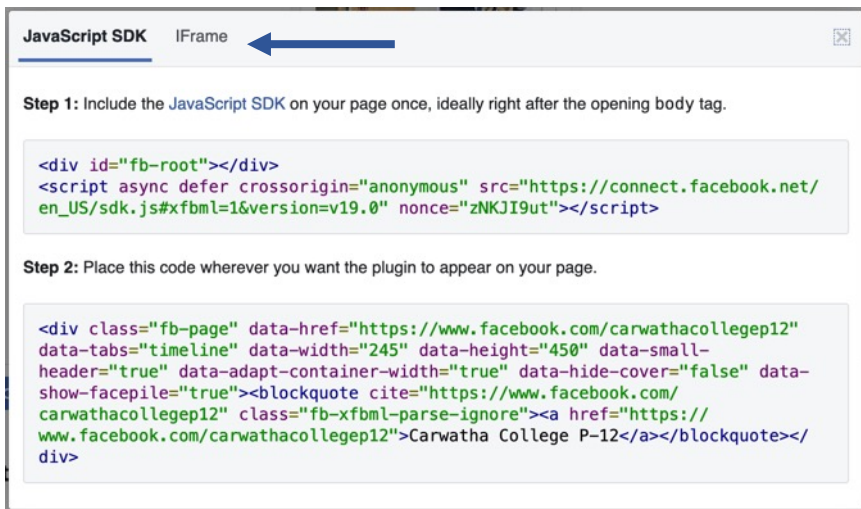
- A preview of your feed will display underneath these options.



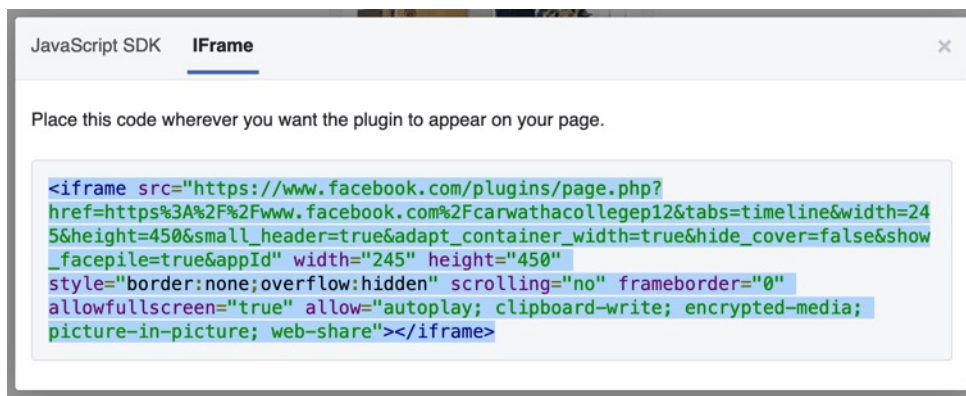
- Just underneath this preview you will see a **Get Code** button, click on this.



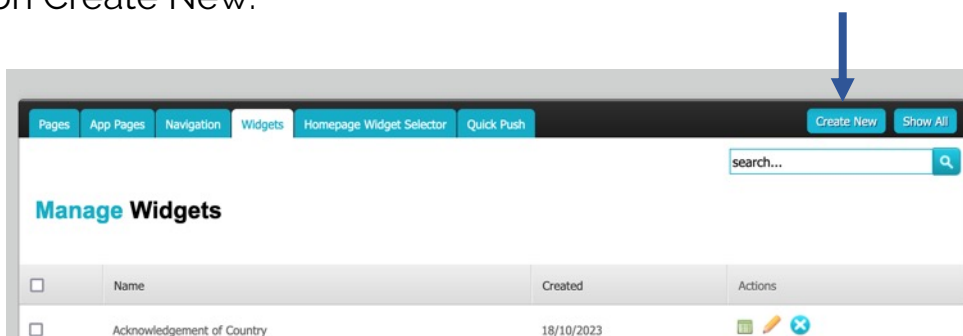
- It will open a pop up window like the one below. At the top, click on iFrame.



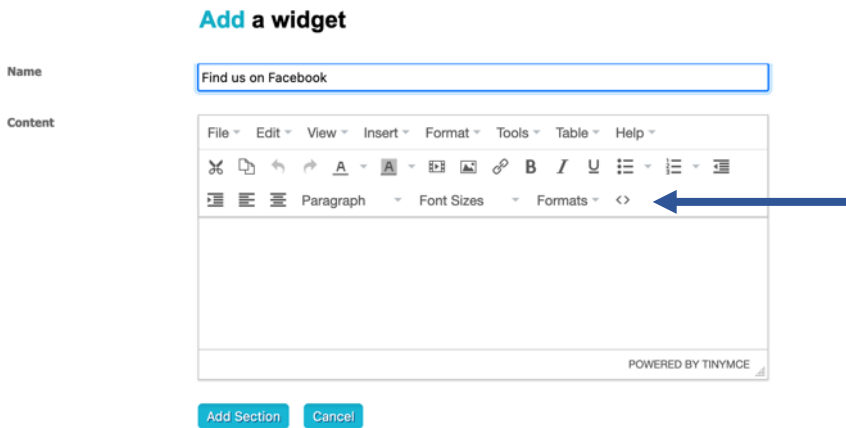
- Select all the iframe code and copy it.



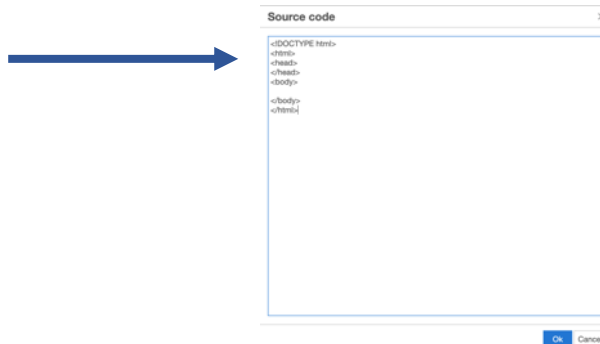
- Login to your website and go to WEBSITE CONTENT – Widgets. Click on Create New.



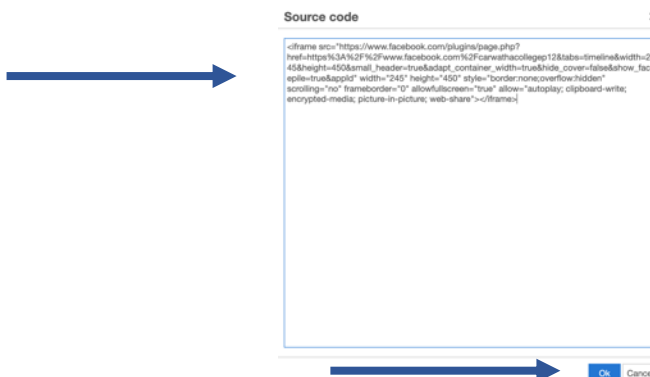
- Give the widget a title. Then on the toolbar on the bottom row you will see a code button that looks like this <>. Click on it.



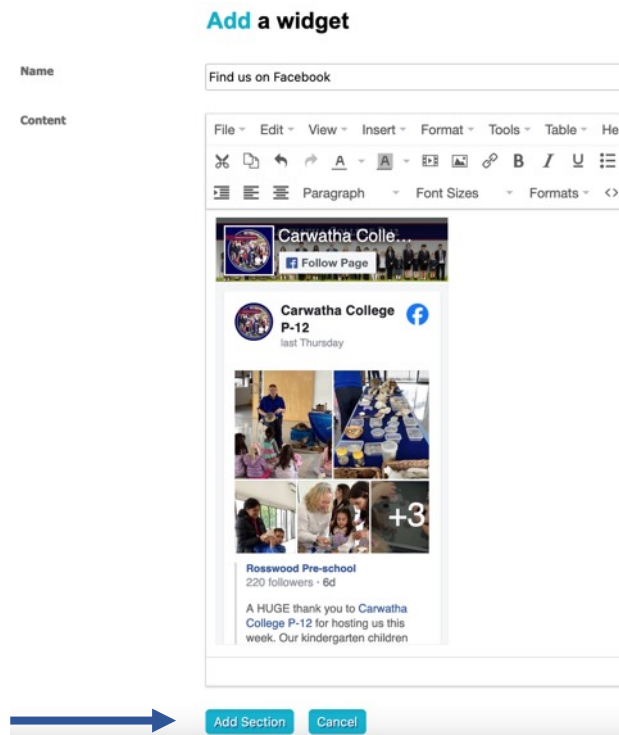
- It will open a pop up window, with some basic code. You can delete this.



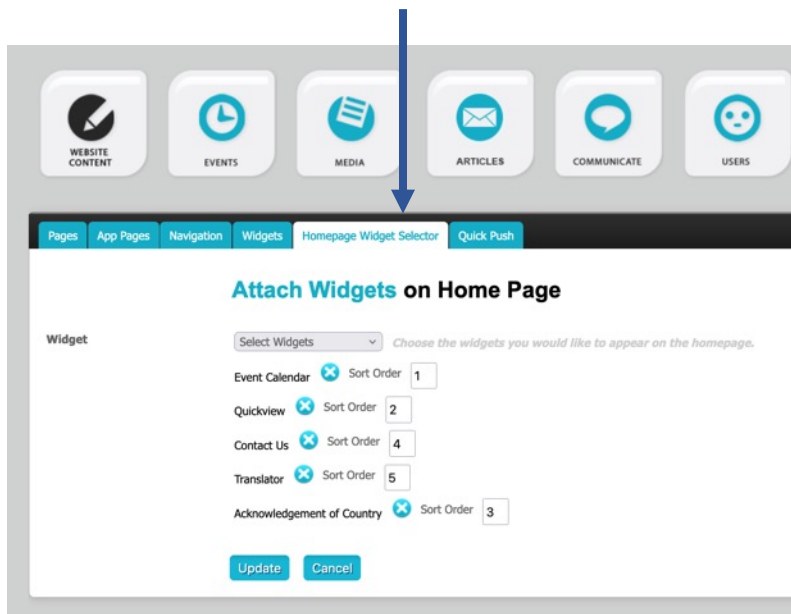
- Paste your code into the pop up window. Click OK.



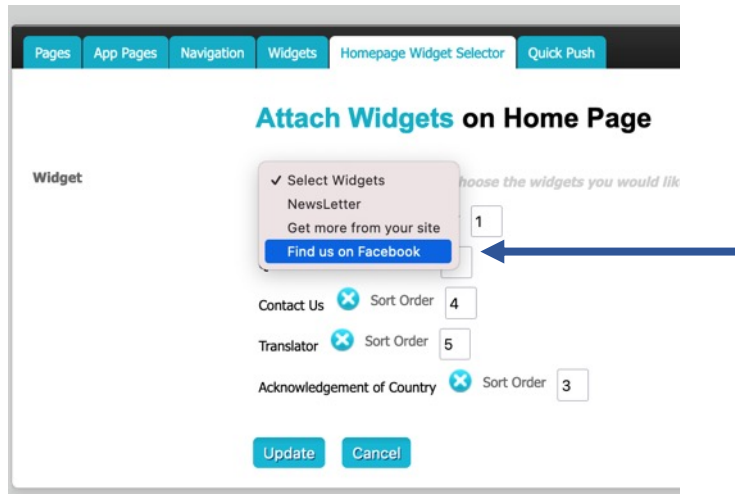
- You will land back on your widget and see a preview of it. Then click on Add Section at the bottom.



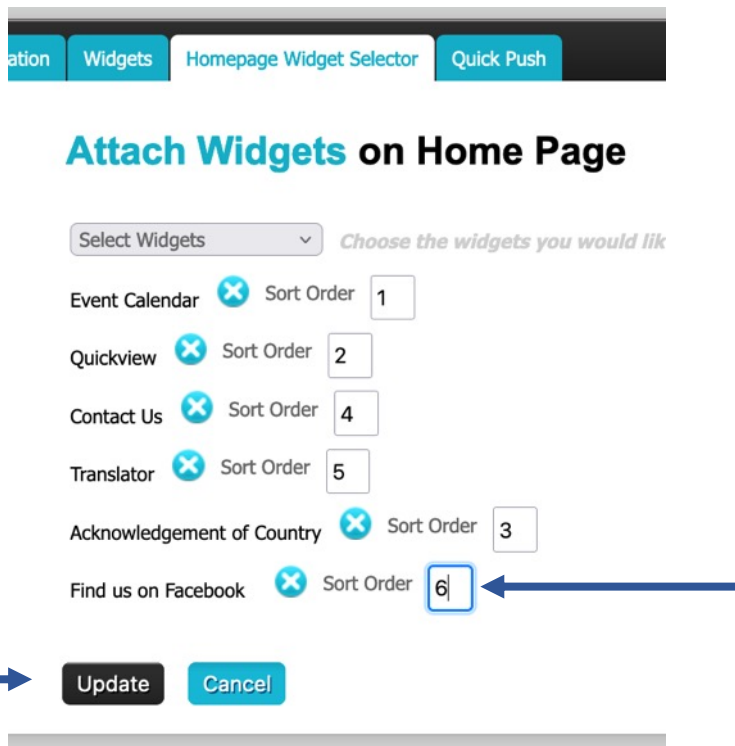
- It is now created, but we need to house the widget. We are putting this on the Homepage.
- Under Website Content – click on Homepage Widget Selector.



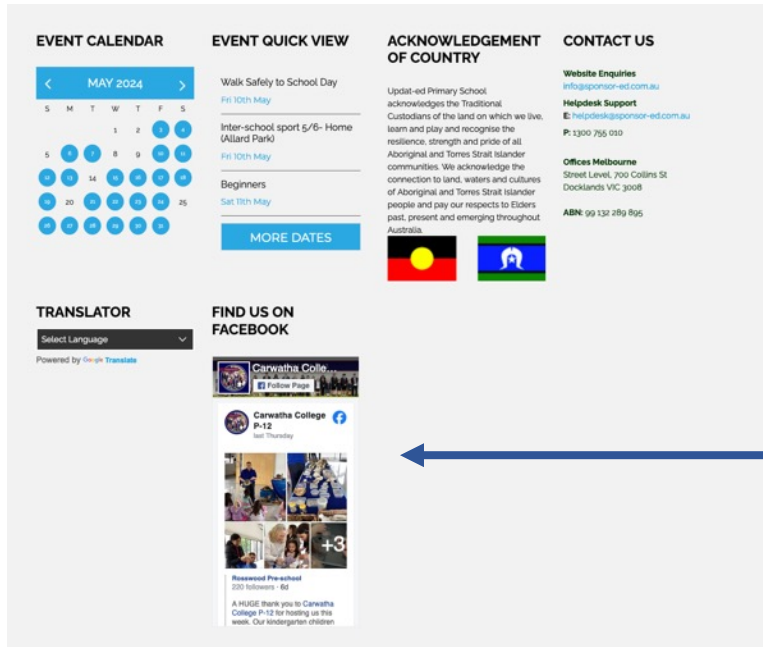
- From the dropdown menu, choose your new facebook widget.



- You will need to give it a sequence. 1 – 4 are top row, left to right. Widgets 5 start a new row etc. We will put this in position 6. Click Update.



- Visit your site and see your new facebook widget.



## TROUBLESHOOTING

- If your facebook feed does not display, this will more than likely be region based issues in your facebook settings. The page must be set to PUBLIC and not restricted to "Australia Only".
- If your facebook feed does not display at the bottom of your page it is also likely that this is blocked by the department within the school network. You can test this by visiting your site on your phone (not connected to school network) and see the widget how the parents will view it.
