

# Google Translator Widget

The google translator widget is a handy tool if you have a demographic that speaks/reads a variety of languages. The widget only needs to be created once, then it can be placed on all pages and articles on your site so that the information is easily accessible by all.

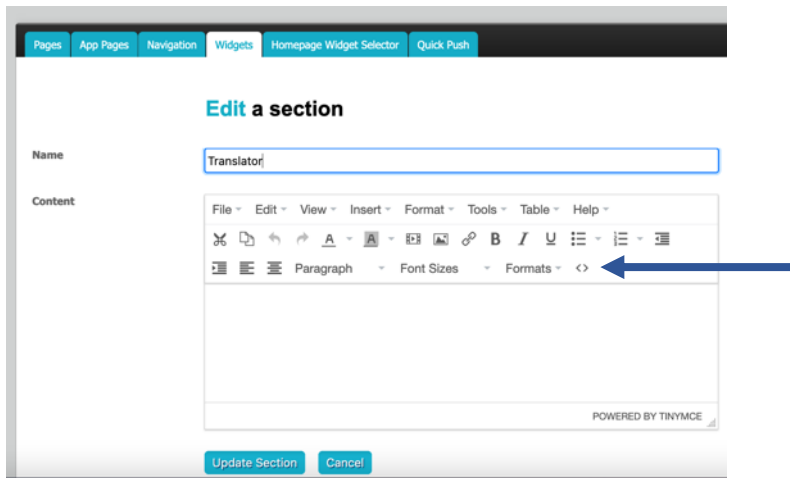
Your Updat-ed website can now embed HTML code from any application making their code available. You can see how these widgets appear on your site by just looking right.

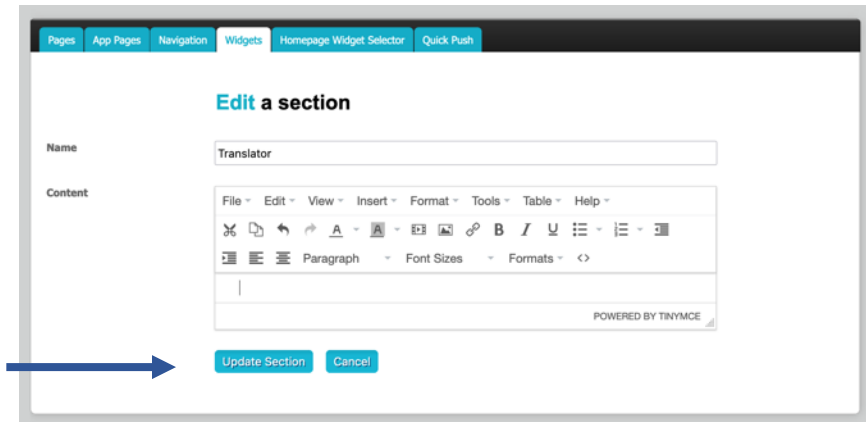
- Give the widget a name.
- In the toolbar on the content box, you will see a code button. It looks like this <>. Click on this button



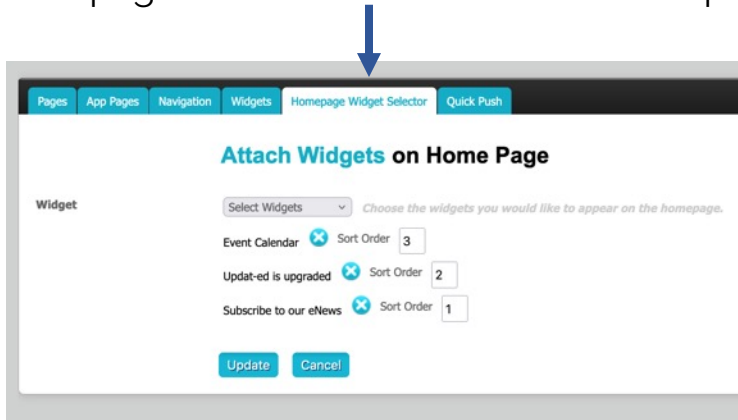
- It will open a pop up window with some code. You can delete the code that is in the window and then paste your new code that you copied from our site in its place. Then click OK.



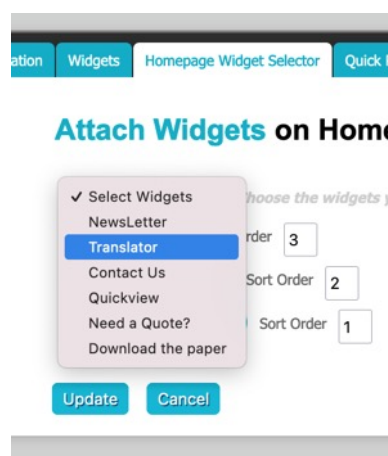
- It will look like there is nothing in there – but it's because it is code. Just click **Update Section**.



- Now that you have created the translator widget, you will need to house it on your homepage and every page of your website.
- For homepage: WEBSITE CONTENT – Homepage Widget Selector



- Click on the drop down menu “Select Widgets” and choose your translator widget.



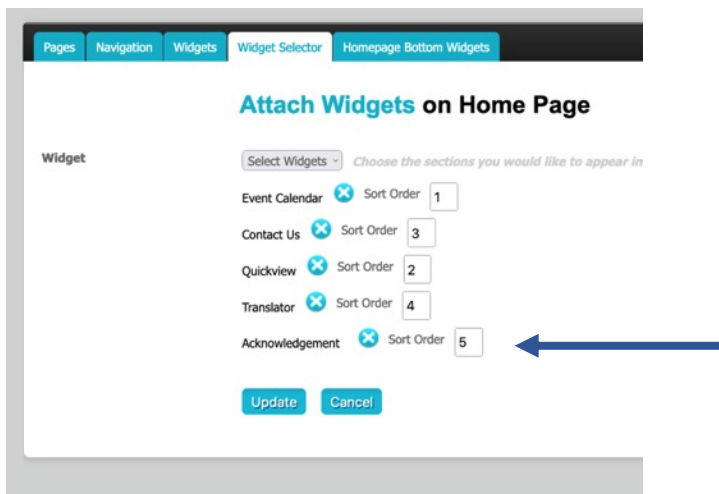
- You will then give it a "Sort Order" which is a number – the widgets are numbered from L-R at the bottom of your homepage, 4 per line. Click **Update**.



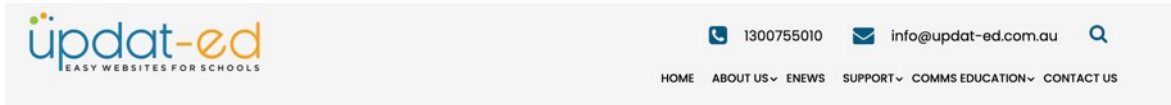
- Click on the drop down menu and choose your widget.



- Give it a "sort order" 1 being the TOP (these widgets run down the right hand side of your pages). Then **Submit** your changes at the bottom of this screen.



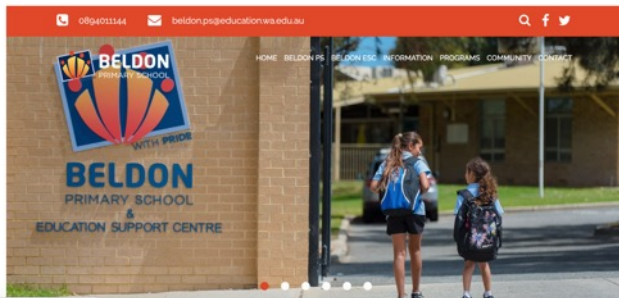
- Visit your site to see the new widget on your page. Repeat for all pages on your site.
