This guide will show you how to create a new page and insert it into the Navigation so that it is visible on your site.


1. WEBSITE CONTENT – Pages Click on *Create New*



2. Select *Normal Page* from the dropdown menu.




3. Give your page a title.


4. Type your information into the *Content* box.



5. Underneath the content box, you will find the following have been pre-selected: *Show in Navigation*

6. Click on *Submit*. If you are creating a *Private Password Protected Page*, please select private from the access type.



Your new page has been created, now it is time to place it in your site map so that your audience can see it.

- 6. Find the position in your navigation where you would like your new page to appear and click on the + button.
- 7. Click on the drop down menu to sort through the pages newly created pages generally end up at the bottom of the menu.







7. Items on the very left are your **Main Navigation** pages – these appear on your homepage. If you indent the page once – it becomes a secondary page – so it is then a page within a heading on your Main Navigation. See below:


8. In this instance "Creating a page" is a secondary page underneath the title "About Us".
